Come with us to Vietnam!

This is your chance to get a unique and international learning experience and make friends for life. We will spend two exciting weeks exploring what Vietnam has to offer. During the two weeks you will visit companies and public institutions, learn about Vietnamese business culture and environment, attend lectures at Ho Chi Minh University of Technology, work with likeminded Vietnamese students and not least visit fantastic cultural, historic, and natural sites. If brief you will learn "How to do business in Vietnam" and gain new perspective on your own culture and your international career opportunities.



Why go to Vietnam?

Three good reasons to come with me to Vietnam.

First reason the people and the culture. Vietnamese people are extremely friendly and open, and the Vietnamese culture is relaxed and friendly. If you join us, you will surely leave with many new Vietnamese friends, and many great memories.

Secondly, Vietnam is a country on the rise, both in economic terms, where they outrank countries like China in growth, but also mentally. From being a closed country just 10 years ago, they are now embracing new technology and foreign influence, while still maintaining their own identity.

The third reason is the food and the nature. In Vietnam, you will find the best beaches, the most beautiful nature, and delicious (and healthy) food at a VERY low price.

So, join the Vietnam Summer School in a country that you will never forget and most likely visit again.



The basics

- Prices in Vietnam are generally cheap, often less than a third of the prices in DK.
- Currency: 100.000 Vietnamese DONG is approx. 30 DKKR or 4 €
- Insurance is a must have! You might be covered by your existing policies (Inbo), check it out.
- Vaccinations! Ask your doctor or check www.sikkerrejse.dk
 but I can say that Hepatitis A and Tetanus & Diphtheria is a must. Others will depend on length of stay and region.
- Visa: Depends on your nationality. Danes can stay 45 days without visa (at the time of writing this).
 If you stay longer than 45 days, you must have a VISA.
 It costs approx. 17US\$ or 120 DKK and can be ordered and paid directly online.

What does it cost?

Dania covers the expenses for classes at the University. You cover your own travel and living expenses.

- Flights: You can get ticket from 8-12.500 DKr. Usually, flights with three connections are cheaper! There are no direct flights from Denmark to Vietnam. Remember to check out how much it costs to fly from Hamburg as this is usually cheaper.
- Accommodation: We stay at Huong Sen Hotel. The Hotel is central, safe, have a small rooftop pool and is the center of our social activities with the University. Last year prices (2023): 50 USD for single, 60USD for double, 70USD triple room incl. breakfast.
- Food: Best in the world and cheap! A good meal in a restaurant
 with a beer is app. 100,000d (30 DKK). Street food with a beer/soda
 can be found for around half price of that. In general, the food safety
 is quite good in Vietnam if you eat in restaurants and even most
 street food stands are safe.
- Getting around: It's cheap and safe and around using local taxis and it is even cheaper to take a Scooters. Most students use the app Grab, where you can book the ride and see the price in advance.
- Travel in Vietnam, before or after the Summer School?

 No problem and there are plenty of great places and scenery to see.

 Transportation is cheap and affordable in Vietnam. Vietnam Airlines if you go by plane, and Futabus if you go by bus, are good options.

 Regarding plane tickets, make sure to book in good time to get a low price. Remember to get a visa if you prolong your stay. I traveled most of Vietnam, so ask if you want tips.

Living there

- Laundry? Pick-up service available all over HCMC. Price around 30.000d (3 DKK) per kilo. Don't launder expensive or colorful clothes as the Vietnamese LOVE to use bleach. Do not use hotel laundry
- Local SIM card? Cheap, good, and easy to use for reasonable price. Can be bought in airport.
- Mosquito spray? A must have! The mosquito spray we have in DK does not work well in Vietnam. You must find mosquito spray that contains the ingredient "DEET". Buy it in Sweden or Germany – or easier in Vietnam.
- Nightlife? Many options to go out in HCMC. You must try a SKY bar and a karaoke bar.
- Safety: In general, it is safe in HCMC and Vietnam, and in the area around the hotel you can feel quite safe.
- Should I bring extra money for clothes? I always do! There is opportunity to get good and cheap deals on clothes, shoes etc.
- Money: There are lots of ATMs in HCMC and besides this you can use credit cards many places, so no need to bring Euro or US Dollars - It's cheaper to withdraw at the ATMs.
